Coupled with a tasteful interior and refined ride and handling characteristics that excel in all conditions, Jeep Compass offers a unique blend of premium styling, capability, efficiency and value that is unmatched in the compact-SUV segment.

Offering the amenities and interior flexibility of an SUV with the performance, handling, fuel economy and price of a compact car, the 2013 Jeep Compass also boasts more than 30 standard and available safety and security features, including standard Electronic Stability Control (ESC), Electronic Roll Mitigation, Hill-Start Assist (with manual transmission), side-curtain air bags for all rows and available front-seat-mounted side air bags.

The 2013 Jeep® Compass offers an array of clever features consumers will appreciate whether commuting to work or exploring new trails. Features such as Uconnect™ media centre with iPod interface, SiriusXM™ Satellite radio with one year subscription, navigation, Uconnect hands-free communication with Bluetooth streaming audio, power sunroof, a premium audio system with nine Boston Acoustics® speakers, illuminated cup holders, liftgate speakers and fold-flat rear seats are some

of the available unique features that make the Jeep Compass the perfect compact SUV, enabling consumers to enjoy any adventure.

The 2013 Jeep Compass is also packed with standard features that provide style and convenience for drivers and passengers. Standard features include, 17-inch aluminum wheels, fog lamps, cruise control, illuminated cup holders, a removable/rechargeable light, outside temperature display, Electronic Stability Control, Electronic Roll Mitigation, Hill-start Assist, front driver and passenger reactive head restraints, all-row side-curtain air bags, anti-lock brakes, and 60/40 fold-flat rear seats.

For 2013, Chrysler Canada will continue to offer the popular North All-Season Group on the Jeep Compass North 4x2 and 4x4 models. The package includes remote start system (with CVT), heated front seats and leather wrapped steering wheel with audio controls.

Segment-leading Capability

The 2013 Jeep Compass offers customers Best-in-Class 4x4 off-road capability with Jeep Freedom Drive II® and is the most fuel efficient 4x4 SUV in Canada.

Jeep Compass is available in three drivetrain configurations. In addition to the standard front-wheel-drive system, it is also available with Freedom Drive I® and the Freedom Drive II® Off-Road Group.

Jeep Freedom Drive I is an available full-time, active four-wheel-drive system with lock mode, designed to give drivers year-round assurance with the ability to handle rough weather and low-traction conditions. This active four-wheel-drive system is recommended for daily use, including slick conditions that come with rain and light snow. Freedom Drive I also features a lockable centre coupling, giving drivers the ability to put the Jeep Compass in four-wheel-drive lock mode to handle deep snow, sand and other low-traction surfaces.

The Jeep® Freedom Drive II Off-Road Group is an available four-wheel-drive system that delivers Jeep Trail Rated® capability for those seeking a true off-road adventure. The Freedom Drive II Off-Road Group includes a second-generation continuously variable transaxle with low range (CVT2) that engages when the off-road mode is activated, 17-inch all-terrain tires, one-inch raised ride height, full-size spare tire, skid plates, tow hooks, and manual seat height adjuster. The available Freedom Drive II Off-Road Group is recommended for moderate off-road situations that include steep grades, occasional wheel lift and rock or log climbing.

The 2013 Jeep Compass' powertrain is designed to deliver world-class performance in all weather conditions, with exceptional fuel economy and refinement, all at an affordable, value-packed price.

Jeep Compass features the proven 2.0-litre I-4 cylinder or 2.4-litre I-4 cylinder engines for the 2013 Jeep Compass Sport and North and the 2.4-litre I-4 cylinder engine standard on Limited models that provides 172 horsepower and 165 lb.-ft. of torque coupled with the five-speed manual transmission that delivers excellent 9.0 L/100 km (31 mpg) in the city, and 7.0 L/100 km (40 mpg) on the highway.

This 2.4-litre I-4 cylinder engine has dual variable-valve timing (VVT) on both intake and exhaust camshafts, which helps optimize the torque curve at all speeds and produces more power, better fuel economy and smoother, quieter operation than engines without dual VVT. Dual VVT is a technology that is typically not available on vehicles sold in Canada in the Jeep Compass' price class.

Jeep Compass also features a standard five-speed manual transaxle on the entry-level Compass Sport model, North and Limited. A CVT is also available on every Compass model. The Compass' CVT2 is a second-generation CVT that Chrysler Group engineers calibrated for precise ratio control. CVT2 contributes to a fuel economy improvement of 6 to 8 per cent compared with a traditional four-speed automatic. The Compass CVT2 also improves vehicle performance compared with a traditional automatic transaxle because of optimized gear ratios, especially in the 50–100 km/h range during passing maneuvers.

When properly equipped, the 2013 Jeep Compass also provides unsurpassed maximum towing up to 907 kg (2,000 lb.).

Jeep® Compass Model Lineup

The 2013 Jeep Compass is available in three configurations: Compass Sport, North and Limited. All are available with four-wheel drive capability: the Freedom Drive I full-time, active 4x4 system or the Freedom Drive II Off-Road Package full-time, active 4x4 system with low-range capability.

Jeep Compass Sport Model

The 2013 Jeep Compass Sport model is powered by the 2.0-litre I-4 or, for those looking for increased power, it is also available with a 2.4-litre I-4 engine mated to a five-speed manual transmission or CVT transmission. Standard features include: Electronic Stability Control, Electronic Roll Mitigation, Hill-start Assist, advanced multi-stage front driver and passenger air bags, all-row side curtain air bags, front driver and passenger reactive head restraints, 16 or 17-inch aluminum wheels, anti-lock front disc, rear drum brakes, illuminated cup holders, steering wheel mounted cruise control, removable/rechargeable flashlight, floor mats, outside temperature display, rear 60/40 split folding seat, fold-flat rear seat, cruise control, projector fog lamps, and bright roof side rails.

Jeep Compass North Model

In addition to the features that are standard on the Sport model, the 2013 Jeep Compass North standard features include: air conditioning, power windows and locks, remote keyless entry, illuminated entry, power heated mirrors with manual fold-away, body-colour exterior door handles and liftgate brow, deep tint sunscreen glass, driver seat height adjuster, fold-flat front passenger seat, 60/40 rear seat recline, and a 115-volt power outlet.

Jeep Compass Limited Model

The 2013 Compass Limited model offers the standard features of the Compass North model as well as: leather-faced front seats, heated front seats, four-wheel disc anti-lock brakes, manual driver lumbar adjust, leather-wrapped steering wheel with audio controls, six-way power driver seat, Electronic Vehicle Information Centre (EVIC), SiriusXM™ Satellite Radio with one year subscription, auto-dimming rearview mirror, 18-inch aluminum wheels, automatic temperature control, bright exhaust tip and bright accents on front and rear fascia.

The 2013 Jeep Compass is available in the following exterior colours: Black Clear Coat, Bright Silver Metallic Clear Coat, Bright White Clear Coat, Deep Cherry Red Crystal Pearl Coat, Mineral Grey Metallic Clear Coat, Winter Chill Pearl Coat, Black Forest Pearl Coat, and True Blue Pearl Coat.

Available options include Freedom Drive I and Freedom Drive II four-wheel drive systems, North All-Season group, Trailer Tow Prep Group, Sun and Sound Group, Uconnect™ hands-free communication with Bluetooth® streaming audio, driver- and passenger-front-seat mounted air bags, SiriusXM™ Satellite Radio Group, premium nine-speaker audio system with liftgate speakers and navigation.

The Jeep Compass is built at the Belvidere Assembly Plant in Belvidere, Illinois, U.S.A.

The 2013 Jeep Compass models will begin arriving in dealer showrooms in the third quarter of 2012.
