## **About the 2017 Dodge Challenger**

The Dodge and SRT brands offer the most complete lineup of muscle cars in the market, including the 2017 Dodge Challenger SXT with its standard powerful and fuel-efficient Pentastar V-6 engine combined with the TorqueFlite eight-speed transmission that delivers 305 horsepower and fuel economy as efficient as 7.8 L/100km (36 mpg); the Dodge Challenger R/T with the high-torque 5.7-litre HEMI® paired with the TorqueFlite eight-speed or six-speed manual transmission; and the 6.4-litre HEMI Challenger R/T Scat Pack that delivers 485 horsepower and 475 lb.-ft. of torque with the

TorqueFlite eight-speed or six-speed manual. The Dodge Challenger SRT 392 adds front six-piston Brembo brakes, adaptive damping suspension and SRT Drive Modes to the same 6.4-litre naturally aspirated HEMI powerplant, while the Challenger SRT Hellcat with its 707 horsepower 6.2-litre Supercharged HEMI SRT Hellcat V-8 engine is the most powerful and fastest muscle car ever.
