#### What's New for 2017

- New Journey GT model replaces R/T as top-level model for 2017. Standard features include:
  - 283 horsepower 3.6-litre Pentastar V-6 engine, performance suspension and precise steering feel for sportier handling
  - · All-wheel drive for added traction and control in all weather conditions
  - Black leather-faced seats with accent stitching, heated steering wheel, and 19-inch Tech Silver aluminum wheels add to the sporty character of the GT
  - A premium six-speaker 368-watt sound system with subwoofer
- Two all-new exterior paint colours available on Journey for 2017: Spitfire Orange and Bruiser Grey join the rest of Journey's exterior paint colour lineup, which includes Redline Pearl, Jazz Blue Pearl, Olive Green, Granite Crystal Metallic, Billet, Pitch Black, White and Pearl White Tri-Coat

#### About the 2017 Dodge Journey

The 2017 Dodge Journey is the most affordable and most powerful three-row mid-size crossover in the country. As Canada's favourite crossover, it is also the most versatile, offering the choice of four- or sixcylinder engines, five- or seven-passenger seating, front or all-wheel drive and a myriad of storage solutions including the class-exclusive second-row in-floor storage bins with removable, washable liners. Journey continues to offer customers better value while delivering vehicle connectivity and customization with the available 8.4-inch touchscreen infotainment system. With standard fold-flat rear seats, second-row in-floor storage and optional front-passenger Flip 'n Stow in-seat storage, the Journey is a true utility player. The Dodge Journey has more than 50 standard and available safety and security features and is Canada's most affordable seven-seat crossover. For 2017, the Dodge Journey is available in Canada Value Package, SE Plus, SXT, Crossroad FWD, GT AWD and Crossroad AWD trim levels.



## **Highlights**

- Dodge Journey is a true utility player among crossovers, offering the choice of four- or six-cylinder engines and five- or seven-passenger seating. The new Journey GT model comes standard with all-wheel drive, which is also available on the Crossroad trim.
- Journey's available all-wheel-drive system works on demand, driving only the front wheels until power to the rear wheels is needed to maximize fuel efficiency. All-wheel drive also is used on dry pavement between speeds of 40 and 105 km/h to enhance handling.
- The award-winning 3.6-litre Pentastar V-6 engine, standard on SXT, Crossroad and GT models, produces 283 horsepower and 260 lb.-ft. of torque and is mated to a smooth-shifting six-speed automatic transmission
- Journey CVP and SE Plus trims feature the standard 2.4-litre 16-valve DOHC four-cylinder engine, which produces 173 horsepower and 166 lb.-ft. of torque, linked to a four-speed automatic transmission
- Journey maintains sculpted, clean, aggressive lines and a front fascia that sports the signature Dodge brand "split crosshair" grille. Available bold "ring of fire" LED tail lamps feature a distinctive style, while 19-inch aluminum wheels, standard on Crossroad and GT and available on SXT, provide a dramatic styling statement.
- Featuring an available largest-in-class 8.4-inch touchscreen, standard Keyless Enter 'n Go with proximity entry and push-button start and available heated steering wheel, Dodge Journey offers a slew of high-tech features at a price that is still affordable for Canadian families
- Journey's touchscreen multimedia centres offer available navigation and hands-free communication with Bluetooth streaming audio. With its touchscreen display and user-friendly, touch-key categories, connecting and controlling personal devices is simple, intuitive and customizable.
- Four levels of multimedia centres are available, featuring either 4.3- or 8.4-inch touchscreens and available SiriusXM satellite radio with one-year subscription
- Innovative removable storage bins in the floor ahead of the second-row seats, which can hold everything from muddy clothes to soda cans, conceal valuables such as a camera, laptop or purse
- Journey's interior is both spacious and functional. Second-row and available third-row seats fold flat to create up to 1,914 litres (67.6 cu. ft.) of cargo space on 5-passenger models. Second-row seats recline and have available class-exclusive integrated child booster seats. Available thirdrow seating is a popular option that is available on all trim levels while front-passenger Flip 'n Stow in-seat storage is available on SXT models and standard on Crossroad and GT.
- Journey has more than 50 standard and available safety and security features

- Multistage front passenger air bags, active head restraints, electronic stability control with allspeed traction control, electronic roll mitigation and Brake Assist, driver-side knee blocker air bag, side-curtain air bags covering all three rows, front seat-mounted side air bags, LATCH child seat anchor system and trailer-sway control are standard on all Dodge Journey models
- Blacktop Package (available on SXT) includes black roof rails, Gloss Black exterior mirrors, fascia applique, grille and 19-inch aluminum wheels
