Mopar Unleashes Limited-edition Mopar '16 Ram Rebel

The Ram Truck and Mopar brands recently announced the introduction of the **Mopar '16 Ram Rebel**, the most recent limited-edition vehicle created using a unique selection of products from the service, parts and customer-care brand of FCA Canada.

The Mopar '16 Ram Rebel features a limited production of just 500 vehicles, upgraded with Mopar options. Additional performance parts and accessories are available at the FCA retailer for even further customization.

The Mopar '16 Ram Rebel starts with the Ram 1500 4x4 Rebel Crew Cab, built at the Warren Truck Assembly Plant in Warren, Michigan, USA. Two colour options will be available: Flame Red/Brilliant Black two-tone or Brilliant Black monotone.

A Mopar Package created for the Mopar '16 enhances the already unique exterior design cues of the Rebel. The package includes an aluminum, dual bezel sport performance hood embellished with a matte-black hood graphic. Off-road wheel flares bulge out to add both style and substance. A special Mopar blue-and-black graphic stripe accents both sides of the Mopar '16, as well as the tailgate.

The package also features a skid plate to guard the power steering box and substitutes a black front bumper skid plate for the standard billet silver colour. Seventeen-inch satin black wheels tie-in with the blacked out front for added continuity and visual appeal. Rounding out Mopar factory-installed content is a serialized Mopar '16 glove box badge and a set of stainless-steel door sill guards, with the front sill guards embossed with the Ram logo.



Optional parts and accessories are available at from the Mopar parts counter at the retailer for those who want to take personalization of the Mopar '16 Ram Rebel to the next level. In the performance arena, a cold air intake and cat-back exhaust system free up the flow of the HEMI V-8 engine while adding an aggressive sound.

As with previous limited-edition Mopar vehicles, the Mopar '16 Ram Rebel is delivered with a custom owner's kit. The limited-edition vehicle will be available in both the U.S. and Canada.

Mopar: At the Strip

A pair of champions are carrying the Mopar banner on the quarter-mile in 2016, as **back-to-back NHRA Pro Stock champ Erica Enders and five-time overall Pro Stock title winner Jeg Coughlin Jr**. are leading the charge for the brand in the popular factory hot rod class.

In the NHRA Funny Car class, **Mopar and Don Schumacher Racing (DSR)** continue one of the most successful and longest running partnerships in the sport. DSR teammates Matt Hagan, Jack Beckman, Ron Capps and Tommy Johnson Jr. combined to place the new Dodge Charger R/T body that debuted in 2015 in the final round at all but one of 24 events during the 2015 season, amassing a total of 15 wins and placing all four Mopar cars in the top five of the standings. Two-time NHRA Funny Car champ Hagan will once again pilot the flagship Mopar Express Lane Dodge Charger R/T Funny Car.

In the NHRA Sportsman ranks, the **new Mopar Dodge Challenger Drag Pak**, launched in 2015, hit drag strips across the country, making its debut at the NHRA Gatornationals in Gainesville, Florida. All 60 of the next-generation package cars, including 35 with the brand's first-ever offering of a supercharged 354-cubic-inch Gen III HEMI® engine and 25 powered by a naturally aspirated 426-cubic-inch Gen III HEMI engine, have been ordered by dealers.

Mopar continues its relationship with the Nascar Pinty's Series in Canada as a series partner, contingency sponsor and primary sponsor of the DJK Racing entry of the number 27 Dodge Challenger driven by multi-time champion Andrew Ranger.
